

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

All civil cases are to be filed electronically including all pleadings, all exhibits, all transcripts. This was to have begun July 1, 2017. The Circuit Clerk of Jackson County is authorized to reject any filing that is not in electronic format. Should a *pro se* litigant need assistance with electronic filing the Office of the Circuit Clerk of Jackson County will assist that individual with such filing.

Beginning January 1, 2018 all criminal cases are to be filed electronically including all pleadings, all exhibits, all transcripts. The Circuit Clerk of Jackson County is authorized to reject any criminal filing that is not in electronic format beginning that date. Should a *pro se* litigant need assistance with electronic filing the Office of the Circuit Clerk of Jackson County will assist that individual with such filing.
